The Holy Gospel

The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew. (25: 14-30)

The Lord spoke this parable: A man going on a journey called his servants and entrusted to them his property; to one he gave five talents, to another two, to another one, to each according to his ability. Then he went away. He who had received the five talents went at once and traded with them; and he made five talents more. So also, he who had the two talents made two talents more. But he who had received the one talent went and dug in the ground and hid his master's money. Now after a long time the master of those servants came and settled accounts with them. And he who had received the five talents came forward, bringing five talents more, saying: "Master, you delivered to me five talents; here I have made five talents more." His master said to him, "Well done, good and faithful servant; you have been faithful over a little, I will set you over much; enter into the joy of your master." And he also who had the two talents came forward, saying: "Master, you delivered to me two talents; here I have made two talents more." His master said to him, "Well done, good and faithful servant; you have been faithful over a little, I will set you over much; enter into the joy of your master." He also who had received the one talent came forward, saying: "Master, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you did not sew, and gathering where you did not winnow; so I was afraid, and I went and hid your talent in the ground. Here you have what is yours." But his master answered him, "You wicked and slothful servant! You knew that I reap where I have not sowed, and gather where I have not winnowed? Then you ought to have invested my money with the bankers, and at my coming I should have received what was my own with interest. So take the talent from him, and give it to him who has the ten talents. For to everyone who has will more be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who has not, even what he has will be taken away. And cast the worthless servant into the outer darkness; there men will weep and gnash their teeth." As Jesus said these things He cried out: "He who has ears to hear, let him hear!"

Bible Time



Matthew 25: 14-30

February 7, 2016

Parable of the Talents In today's gospel, Jesus teaches us about the Kingdom of God by using the parable of the talents. This parable illustrates how we are supposed to use the gifts given to us by God. The word talent in this gospel means a large amount of money, so even the servant that was given only one talent was given a very large sum of money. Regardless of what you think of yourself or your circumstances, God has generously given you great gifts and talents; even gifts that seem small have God's huge potential planted within them. The problem with many of us is that we have buried these God-given gifts so deeply so that we do not even know we have them, and so we do not use them. Then there are those who use the talents that God has given them, but not for the reason they were intended – that is, to build up God's Church and to give Him glory.

<u>Different Amounts</u> You may say, well one servant received five times more than another; why didn't they all get the same amount? Well, the gospel says that each person was given an amount that corresponded to that person's abilities. Yes we are all gifted with different things in life, some are given a lot, and others by comparison are given little. It is not what we are given that matters before God — it is what we do with what we are given that matters.

You know the ultimate reward for each faithful servant, regardless of the talents they start with, is the same — each faithful servant will share in the eternal joy of their Master. Don't worry about all the things you may think you're missing in this life; God has equipped you with all the gifts you need to serve Him, with all the gifts that, if used for His glory, will allow you to be richly blessed.

<u>Use Your God-Given Gifts</u> This parable is one that sometimes troubles me. It is a beautiful parable because God confirms that He has given us gifts, Holy gifts that we are to faithfully use. It is also wonderful because we are told that we are each given according to our ability – praise God, we are all growing in our faith, but the Lord does not give us responsibility beyond our ability. So here's where I get a little anxious – the master returns to settle accounts with the servants, and the master will not accept any excuses for laziness or negligence when it comes to the talents he has dispensed to each one of them. Like these servants, we know we will one

day stand before our Master, and on that day of accounting, He expects that we have *fruitfully used* the gifts we have been given. We cannot be like the lazy servant who buries our talents in the earth, and in worldly pursuits.

We need to be like the wise and fruitful servant – we must be resourceful labourers who use our gifts to be profitable to those around us and for the glory of God. How can we figure out what our gifts are, and how we are to use them? We have God's Word to lead and direct our decisions, we have the godly example of the saints, we have the fellowship and direction provided within the church, and we have the Holy Spirit that dwells in us! In other words, we have no excuses.

Yes, God expects us to use the gifts He has given us. For those of us who don't know what those gifts are, we need to pray and ask the Lord to help direct our energies in things that bring us (or those around us) joy and at the same time give glory to God. It is critical to also note that the talents did not belong to the servants – the master freely gave them these talents. When we fully understand that everything we have was given to us by God, it will be much easier to share it with those around us.



Remember This — You have been given something special from God. This talent was carefully and wonderfully etched into you from within your mother's womb. God gave you something that He wants you to use. He wants you to use this talent to minister to those around you, and to serve Him at the same time. This talent is a spiritual gift. By definition, this talent is not to be used for your own personal and private use. If it is from God, it is to be used and shared. Your spiritual gift is your unique capacity to minister to The Body of Christ through this gift. If you allow the Holy Spirit to work through you, God will use this gift to divinely touch and transform the lives of other people. This gift is a vehicle that God wants to work through. You don't own this gift or talent, God simply asks you to manage it in a faithful and fruitful way, and He will do the rest!

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
